

DOCK RULES

(EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 2017)

PURPOSE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To provide maximum benefit to members visiting the Club by boat. • To accommodate visiting race boats participating in GGYC, YRA, and PICYA Races. • To accommodate visiting club cruise-ins.
GENERAL RULES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Overnight berthing is by reservation only. • Cancellations must be made 24 hours in advance. • Yachts are not to be left unattended for more than 12 hours. • Overnight reservations must be made through the GGYC General Manager, Bob Mulhern, at 415-346-2628 or at generalmanager@ggyc.com.
MEMBER USE	Club members are entitled to four (4) nights free berthing per month. Nights cannot be carried forward. The fifth and subsequent nights are subject to a \$25.00 per night charge.
RACE DAY USE	Race days require the docks to be fully available to race participants and those members who have made reservations for over-night stays. The dates for accommodation of racers will be included in the Club's monthly calendar. The first Saturday of November, December, January, February, and March is always reserved for Manuel Fagundes Seaweed Soup Regatta participants and docking is not available. Friday evenings for the Friday Night Races will be published and reserved. Other races may be listed.
CRUISE-INS	All boats using GGYC docks are subject to Race Day limitations. All guests must register with the Club Manager, who shall make a determination as to length of stay based on dock space available. Members of PICYA clubs receive one night of free berthing per month, subsequent nights are charged at \$50.00 regardless of boat size or length of stay. Boaters who are not members of PICYA yacht clubs will be charged \$50.00 per night or \$2.00/foot (based on LOA) per night, whichever is greater, regardless of length of stay.
PRIORITY	In accepting reservations, the priority is GGYC members, race participants, PICYA members, others.
RESTRICTIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boat maintenance work shall not be done at the Club. • Loud partying and electronic music is forbidden. • The length of stay may be terminated by the Club Manager, Commodore, or the Port Captain at any time for just cause.
